The Zonta presentation at the **Graduating Midwives Retreat** on Friday the 11th of November 2022. I thought that there may be an interest within the club to see some of the images taken by Louise Stevens at the event which marked the last day of the students gathering together before their graduation in April 2023.

It was such a joy to have an appreciative and attentive audience of approximately 90 students and staff and there were may opportunities for us to link the purpose of our club and our service activities with the midwifery profession. Our work in supporting victims of domestic violence is extremely relevant, especially where statistically the rate of cases increases when the women are pregnant. Another strong link is our supervision and guidance in organising school students to pack birthing kits destined for pregnant women in developing countries. This session, run by Angela, was perhaps the most compelling in relating to the audience and their future roles.

Erica gave a concise and interesting background to the projects, structure, world-wide involvement and links to important organisations like the United Nations. Gerry spoke about our activities at the EADVS including Oz Harvest, sorting and displaying donation items, organising Christmas hampers for the clients as well as filling many other practical roles to assist the staff at the service.

At the end of the day the students packed 160 breast cuushions which Gerry immediately drove to St Andrew's Hospital. The students also contributed clothing items for the clothing shed at the EADVS.
